Mayor Rahm Emanuel is pushing for the creation of a TIF district to support the massive Lincoln Yards development just before he steps down. If City Council members go along with Rahm's plan for one last corporate handout on his way out the door, \$1.3 billion in public TIF funds will go to wealthy developers at the expense of public schools, parks, and services. This plan is not equitable, protecting business interests and investing in the wealthiest parts of our city. We have an opportunity to invest in the schools that Chicago's students deserve by bringing nurses to every school, increasing special education services, lowering class sizes and providing the educational programs and trauma supports that children need. We cannot afford to keep ignoring housing, schools and other neighborhood needs.
