Dear CPS District-Managed Schools, CTU Leadership and Members,

As agreed upon in the June 2021 CTU / CPS agreement between the Office of Sports Administration and CTU leadership, a one-time allocation of \$5 million dollars was set aside to be distributed to each school for athletic equipment, uniforms and transportation funding for FY23..

OSA wanted to inform all 336 schools covered in the agreement that these payments will be distributed in your FY23 budgetary allotment.

**\*\*Schools that qualified for these funds are listed in this [spreadsheet](#), and were selected based on 2021-2022 participation in CPS Score! and Chicago Public League High School Athletics.**

These funds can **ONLY** be used for uniforms, equipment, supplies or transportation needs for out of school time, athletic practices and games. The funds may not be used for personnel or physical education. The purpose of these funds is to support our student-athletes and coaches through enhanced resources.

Please find examples below on how to appropriately spend the allocated funds.

- Uniforms for team practices and or game competitions to identify your school.
- Equipment to supplement and support athletic practices and games i.e Volleyball Net System, Soccer Goals etc.
- Supplies to supplement and support athletic practices and games i.e Saucer Cones, Dry-Erase Clipboards, Travel Bags, Ball Catchers, Pinnies etc.
- Transportation to and from athletic practices and away competitions.

### **Distribution of Funds:**

Per the agreement, each high school will receive 1.5x the amount each elementary school will receive.

The Office of Budget and Management will monitor the process of spending these funds by setting up account tracking with all funds located in tracking grant 000411 "CTU Payouts".

**Each district-managed high school (81) will receive \$19,920.32 for equipment, uniforms and transportation.**

**Each district-managed elementary school (255) will receive \$13,280.22 for equipment, uniforms and transportation.**
